11TH ANNUAL ENGINEERS DAY 2013

The Engineers Registration Board (ERB) is pleased to inform the engineering community and the general public that the 11th Annual Engineers Day (AED 2013) will be held on **Thursday and Friday, September 5 and 6, 2013** at Mlimani City Conference Hall, along Sam Nujoma Road, Dar es Salaam.

The Annual Engineers Day is the biggest annual event for engineers from all disciplines of engineering practice in Tanzania. It is a forum where engineers, government officials and other stakeholders in engineering from both public and private sector meet and hold a learned discourse on a theme of topical nature to the nation. The event also provides an opportunity for engineers to share and exchange ideas and experiences in the engineering practice. Recommendations emanating from the discussions are forwarded to relevant authorities for necessary action.

The major activities of this years' event shall include:

- Paper Presentations and Discussions;
- Exhibitions of Technologies – whereby various organizations will exhibit various technologies and engineering services; and
- Awarding distinguished Engineers and Best Graduating Engineering Students from local engineering institutions.

The theme for this year's discourse will be: ***“The Impact of Globalization on Engineering Practice in Tanzania”***

Papers shall be on the following areas:

- (i) *Professional Practice, Procedure and Regulations;*
- (ii) *Engineering Professional Services Delivery;*
- (iii) *Engineering Capacity Building;*
- (iv) *Mining Industry: Opportunities for Engineers in the Sector;*
- (v) *ICT in Engineering Practice & Global Knowledge Economy*

A Key Note Address on ***“Impact of Globalization on Engineering Practice in Tanzania”*** will precede the discussions.

All professional engineers who will attend this event will have an added advantage of scoring 16 Professional Development Units (PDUs) in their

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Program. CPD is a prerequisite for all practicing engineers.

Confirmation of participation is through payment of registration fee of Tshs. 250,000/= per participant. The deadline for confirmation is **August 25, 2013**. Those who will register after this date will have to pay Tshs. 300,000/= per participant.
